By Train:

St. David's train station is the main line station at Exeter. It is about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile from the Streatham Campus. It is approx a 15 minute walk from the Streatham Campus. There is a taxi rank at the station, so easy access to taxis, which only cost between £3-6 to reach the Streatham campus.

Taxis can be found outside the main entrance to the station (turn right when leaving the station).

Bus Station:

The main bus station is on Paris Street, about 1 mile from the Streatham Campus, and $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile from the St. Luke's Campus. A local bus service around the City is run by 'Stagecoach'. A service (D Bus) runs from the city centre to St. Luke's and the Streatham Campus every 30 minutes during the day Monday – Saturday.

Car Parking at Holland Hall is free for residential delegates on a first come first served basis. They will be given a parking permit when registering at reception. For non residential delegates there are pay and display machines located around the University Campus. Charges apply 8am-6pm, Monday to Friday. There are no parking charges at weekends or after 6pm in the evenings. The charge during weekdays are as follows:

- up to 1 hour - £0.60
- up to 2 hours - £1.00
- up to 4 hours - £2.00
- over 4 hours - £3.00
