Arctic Prediction in a Changing Climate

Understanding Key Processes and Challenges

The Arctic is the most rapidly warming region on Earth and is facing considerable environmental change. But whilst accurate forecasting for the region is increasingly important it is technically challenging, with forecasts being significantly less accurate than for the mid-latitudes.

To address the issues, the Year of Polar Prediction (YOPP) was developed as one of the key elements of the WMO's Polar Prediction Project.

Speakers at this meeting will discuss recent advances, and challenges associated with understanding and prediction of key Arctic processes using numerical models and observations. This will include new insights provided by several field campaigns and modelling experiments carried out under the YOPP umbrella.
