Annual 2018/1918.

Observers Notes 2018.

Derby: The fourth warmest year since 1952; the lowest number of rain-days since 2011 (mean 175 days); 38 days with maxima above 25 C (mean 15 days); 31 air frosts (mean 37). The total rainfall for 2018 would have been 100% set against the 1961-90 average, however the average for the period 1971-2000 is now 714 mm.

Mickleover: The fourth warmest year on the station record (1981). The diurnal temperature range of 19.3 C, on 25th June, was the highest on the station record.
