

The Royal Meteorological Society (RMetS), in association with WeatherPro, have selected 24 finalists for this year's Weather Photographer of the Year competition. To view all of the short-listed images, please visit the exhibition during lunch today.

The search for the 2019 Weather Photographer of the Year began earlier this year with a call for the best photographs depicting weather from around the world. Entries ranged from weather phenomena such as clouds, lightning, rain, fog or snow through to the impact of weather on humans, cities and the natural landscape.

More than 5,700 photographs were submitted from nearly 2,000 photographers, creating a challenging task for the selectors to narrow down the best images to be awarded prizes and become part of the Weather Photographer of the Year exhibition. All winners will be announced during today's event and after viewing the images, no doubt you will be inspired to develop your photography and enter one of our future competitions – your photo could feature here next year!
