Summer 2021.

Observers Notes.

Mountsorrel: A warmer, drier but duller than normal summer. June began warm and sunny until the 16th. Four weeks of cooler, showery weather followed before a very warm to hot week from July 16th to 23rd. After this and, for most of the entire school holiday, it was mainly cool and showery.

Derby: The mean temperature for Summer 2021 is the sixth warmest on the station record (1952).

Middleton: The Summer of 2021 was the seventh warmest on the station record (1977) and the mean minimum temperature was the third highest.

Ely: Summer overall was slightly below normal, although the difference from average mean temperature was normal when compared to the 1991-2020 mean. Rainfall was below average. It was the third consecutive summer where temperatures have been lower than the previous year.
