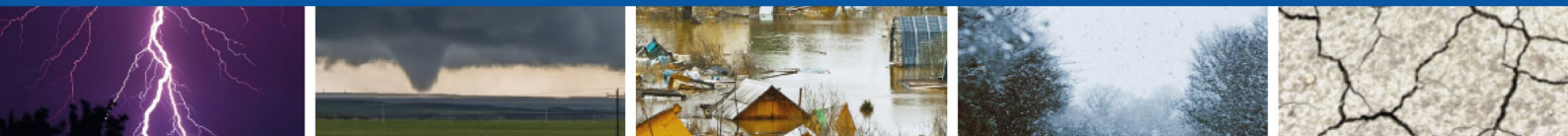



# WeatherLive: From One Extreme to Another
