2nd RMets Climate Change Forum



This year's Royal Meteorological Society Climate Change Forum will draw on the IPCC's Sixth Assessment Working Group reports to explore a 2050 vision for climate change and our responses to it, with a view to raising awareness and building momentum for action on climate change.

The interactive format of the day consists of keynote lectures in the morning, a networking session over lunch, breakout sessions in the afternoon and a poster session with drinks reception to close.

We invite poster abstracts that reflect and build on the day's themes. These include the physical science of climate change, its impacts, our ability to adapt and mitigate, and in particular the implications for the buildings, transport and food sectors. We also welcome relevant submissions on science communication and the science-policy dialogue. The deadline for abstract submission is Friday 30th September at 5pm.

Please note the audience will come from a range of backgrounds. We therefore encourage contributions to be written and presented in plain language.
